

Work-Study Application



NWSSA's mission is to nurture the community of stone sculptors by developing educational opportunities, providing a support system to members, and facilitating interaction with regional, national, and international communities.

The purpose of work/study is to provide artists and students that have a financial need an opportunity to both work at and attend a symposium. A work/study recipient will receive a space on the field and time to carve.

As a work study recipient you are expected to:

- Be available by 9:30 am August 23rd to help with setup and stay on the last symposium day (August 29th) to help with breakdown and clean-up.
- Available in the evenings to help with setup of activities, usually 15-20 minutes before evening events such as lectures and the auction and after events to assure the facility is straightened up.
- On the field at assigned times during the day to help keep things organized and clean (chip barrel management)
- Ad hoc assistance of the field manager with air, electrical, and other problems as they arise.

Work/Study recipients must be in good health and be able to lift 50 pounds. You must be willing to work with the field director and as part of a team to make the symposium a success.

DEADLINE for work/study applications is August 1st 2013). You will be notified by August 10th, 2013 regarding the status of your work/study application.
