NWSSA's mission is to nurture the community of stone sculptors by developing educational opportunities, providing a support system to members, and facilitating interaction with regional, national, and international communities.

New for 2017, NWSSA and the California Stone Sculptor's organization are offering an exchange program scholarship between the International Stone Carving Symposium at Pilgrim Firs in July and the California Sculptors Symposium at Cambria in April. CSS will be awarding a scholarship to one of their active members to attend the Pilgrim Firs symposium and in the spirit of exchange, we are offering the same.

The scholarship to the Cambria symposium covers full registration, room and board for the week of April 23-30, 2017. It does not cover travel expenses or tool or stone purchases on site.

To qualify, you must have attended the symposium at Camp Brotherhood at least two of the previous five years and have intention of attending again within the next two years.

DEADLINE for scholarship applications is **Saturday, March 18 2017, 5:00 p.m.** You will be notified no later than March 23rd regarding the status of your application.

Fill out this application form, either on paper (if handwritten, please print legibly) or electronically and attach required images. Incomplete forms will not be considered. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.

2. Attach up to five (5) images of work.
3. Complete package received by Symposium Director by above published due date: **Saturday, March 18, 5pm**. Applications postmarked, or received electronically, after this date will not be considered.
